A fourth major fabric manufacturer unveiled a local market for Solaris Paper plans to open a factory in western Sydney. [cleaning tissue](#)

The 20 million U.S. plant will create approximately 50 new jobs and will be based Greystanes, [Towel roll manufacture](#) the company Wednesday. [microcotton towels](#)

Solaris operating from Asia Pulp and Paper Group, which has the main action in China and Indonesia.

Solaris Paper Corporate Affairs Director Steve Nicholson said the increased competition will benefit consumers.

I think there are some more Australian consumption choices, Mr Nicholson said Wednesday.

Solaris can import goods in plain paper from China and Indonesia, also known as jumbo rolls, weighing over 2.5 tonnes and convert documents into toilet paper, tissues and napkins.

The final product should be sold to consumers as a whole new market that will be introduced in the second half of 2010.

Solaris will be tissue products for industrial mall, a hotel and office cleaner and one labeled white offer for the house brands from supermarkets.

The company has already imported fabrics from abroad for sale in Australia.
